The Most Significant Brand Update in 15 Years

Beginning 2H 2023

Intel will **no** longer place **generational messaging** in front of Intel® Core™ brand in marketing or in silicon

Generation will still be called out in the processor number (e.g., ##xxxH)

This will apply to **all client products** moving forward, starting with Meteor Lake

Tiering and Naming

Beginning 2H 2023

Intel will drop the “i” from processor tiering on client processors beginning with Meteor Lake, and new products thereafter

Core i3/i5/i7/i9
will shift
to Core 3/5/7/9

These changes
will be reflected
in brand strings, text,
and on badge
